

1.Welcome and Apologies

 Apologies had been received from: Mike Hall, Andy Friend, Janice Shea and Diana Chambers.

2. Chairman's report: Sue Holdich

- Sue reflected on the success of the Friends over the previous financial year. A
 particular highlight had been the 2018 Remembrance Concert, which raised in
 excess of £900 for the charity.
- The Friends granted £545 to the PCC in May 2019, for which David Chambers expressed his appreciation to the committee.
- Sue summarised the fundraising events planned for the forthcoming year: a quiz night at the Bacton Bull, a walking football tournament, and a winter concert by the Ipswich Community Wind Band.

3. Treasurer's Annual report 2018-2019: Andy Friend

- The balance of accounts at 31st March 2019 stood at £13,564
- Net inflow for the full financial year was £2,350. Absence of a metal detecting rally in 2018 accounted for the lower inflow than that seen in previous years.
- Total net income for the Friends (since 2004) stood at £96,807 The Friends expressed their hopes to increase this figure to over £100,000 over the forthcoming financial year.
