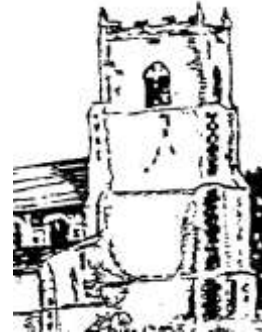

**1. Welcome and Apologies**

- Apologies had been received from: David Chambers, Diana Chambers, Mike Hall, Janice Shea and Andy Friend.

**2. Minutes of the last meeting**

**3. Matters arising**

- Sarah updated the Friends on her contact with Martin Feavearyear of Bacton FC. The committee agreed to wait for a list of fixtures from Martin (expected July/August 2019) before agreeing on a date for the walking football tournament.

**4. Financial Report – Andy Friend**

- The balance of accounts at the end of May\* 2019 stood at £13,710 of which £13,164 was unallocated.
- The sum of £545 had been allocated for repairs to the chancel arch and stabilisation of the Doom.

**5. PCC update – David Chambers**

- During the previous AGM, David thanked the Friends for their grant of £545 towards the work detailed above.

**6. Future fundraising**

- **Walking football tournament:** Sarah agreed to email Martin Feavearyear in July/August, requesting the Bacton FC fixture list for 2019-20. Once received, the Friends would identify a suitable date for the tournament to take place.
- **Concert:** Sarah confirmed that the Ipswich Community Wind Band was booked for a concert on the evening of Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November. The theme of the concert would be 'That's Entertainment – Music from Stage and Screen.' The Friends agreed to discuss ticket prices etc. in their July meeting.
- **Quiz:** Sue and Sarah confirmed that a Pub Quiz had been booked to take place in the Bacton Bull on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July.
  - Tickets were priced at £12.50 per person, £6.50 of which would be retained by the Friends.
  - Ticket sales to date stood at 44 out of a maximum 60
  - Sarah agreed to contact the Bull regarding final arrangements for the room layout, invoicing arrangements etc.
  - Sarah agreed to email committee members, requesting draw prizes for the evening.
