

1.Welcome and Apologies

 Apologies had been received from Pip Wright, Helen Thomson, Diana Chambers and Janice Shea

2. Minutes of the last meeting

 The minutes were accepted as a true copy – proposed by Andy and seconded by Mike.

3. Matters arising

There were no matters arising.

4. Financial Report

 The balance of accounts at the end of January 2020 was £12,137 all of which was unallocated.

5. PCC update

- David reported that Rev. Carl Melville, current rector of Claydon, had been appointed as the new rector of Bacton. The licensing service for Rev. Melville will take place on 2nd April 2020
- An initial survey of the crack in the west side wall of the tower had been conducted and a report received. The cost of the survey was expected to be in the region of £500 The report recommended a survey of the drainage surrounding St. Mary's, which will be organised at a cost of around £200 The Friends agreed to fund both surveys, at a total cost of approximately £700
- The PCC had used a donation from a parishioner to purchase a contactless machine for donations in St. Mary's church. The machine will use wifi to collect

card donations of £3 to £30 and will also calculate any gift aid due. The PCC will ensure wifi access from The Rectory.

6. Reflection on concert held 16.11.19

- The concert generated £541 profit for the Friends.
- It was agreed that the cost of future concert tickets should include a programme.
- There was discussion around the possibility of selling hot drinks at future concerts.

7. Future fundraising

- John Evans had agreed to provide another quiz for the Friends.
- The Friends discussed the possibility of holding another quiz in 2020. The discussions included:
 - o Summer and/or winter quiz.
 - o Potential bigger venues, e.g. marquee at Bacton Fayre.
 - Options for food and refreshments, e.g. The Bull, the Lions, local food traders etc.
